  2. Take exit 128A to merge onto CA-180 E toward Kings Canyon 1.2 mi
  3. Take exit 60A to merge onto CA-168 E toward Huntington Lake/Clovis 5.5 mi
  4. Take exit 6 for Bullard Ave 0.3 mi
  5. Turn right onto W Bullard Ave 0.6 mi
  6. Keep left at the fork 0.2 mi
  7. Turn left onto Pollasky Ave
- Destination will be on the left at the 4th Street intersection
