The minutes were approved as emailed. Stacey Chicoine, treasurer was unable to attend yet she sent the latest Treasurer's Report. Our balance is \$4390.66.

The nominating committee presented the current slate of officers as continuing for the next biennium. Discussion ensued. Membership responsibilities will be shared by the entire membership. Sue DeLong has offered to publish the Rosette. It was moved by Alice Armstrong and seconded by Deloris Mahnke that the slate of officers gain acceptance. The motion passed.

Screen Cleaners were given as party favors by President Virginia. Area 7 will sell screen cleaners at the annual state convention. Under 2: Bibs, rattles, soft books. Teething rings, booties, pacifier, sippy cup or bottle (No tiny toys that could cause choking)

2-4: Dolls, Matchbox cars, Play-Doh, crayons, coloring books, bubbles, card games, soft balls, pain set books, puppets, poseable figurines costume jewelry, soft animal toys (No tiny toys that could cause choking)

4-8: Silly Putty, Play-Doh, paints, books, art supplies bubbles card games puzzles ravel-sized board games plastic animal figurines, cars, dress-up toys, stuffed animals, stickers, Nerf balls

8-11: Card games paints, Silly Putty calculator, Silly String, gel pens, yo-yo, craft kits, brainteasers, books, art supplies, small toys, Nerf balls.

11 and Up: Electronic games, word search and crossword puzzles, books, playing cards, craft kits, brainteasers, journals, art supplies, nail polish, stress balls, travel sized board games
