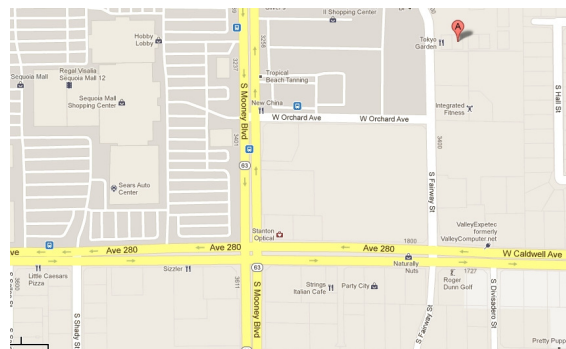

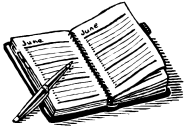

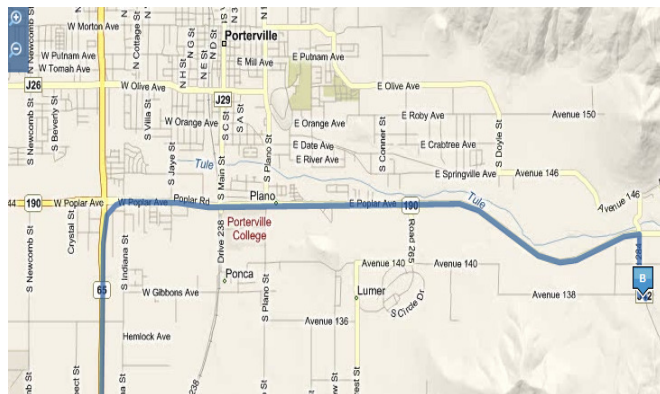

A Minute for the Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 by President Sue De Long.

Officers for the next biennium were discussed. Dorothy Wagy and Virginia Jones will share the president's responsibility for the next biennium. We need to fill the position of treasurer. Members interested in the position should contact Sue De Long immediately. If a member does not fill the position of Program Vice President then the program will be developed by co-chairs month by month. Members will be contacted by email asking for program preferences and topics.

Projects for next year were discussed. Suggestions were: books for select schools, Rose Bags for new teachers, Jared Boxes. Members are encouraged to suggest additional projects, as we have funds available. Deloris Mahnke moved and Virginia Jones seconded the expenditure of \$250 for 5 new teacher Rose Bags in the fall – passed.
