The Purpose of DKG Society International #5 is: To endow scholarships to aid outstanding women educators in pursuing graduate study and to grant fellowships to women educators from other countries.

Choosing [Society Links](#), from the menu at [etazeta.org](#), I explored the DKG California website [dkgca.org/](#) selecting Scholarships which lead me to Scholarship Award Summary. I was pleased to see \$4000 offered for Ph.D/Ed.D candidates and \$2000 for MA/MS candidates. Additionally, a Continuing Education Award of \$300 was described for classes, workshops, seminars, conferences, and other professional development. Application for Outstanding Student Teacher Award of \$150 was also available. Of course, the Penne Ferrell, \$200 grant is awarded to non-members.

Returning to [Society Links](#), the website for DKG International [dkg.org/](#) itemized a Scholarship Fund

of \$6000 for graduate studies and \$10,000 for a doctorate!

Eta Zeta takes the mandate of Purpose #5 very seriously, which is why, we as a chapter offer an Early Career Educator Grant of \$100 this year. Unfortunately, we received no applications for this grant by the deadline of November 1, 2018. Fortunately, Stacey, announced a recalculation of dues and project donations. \$445 for projects and \$400 from dues are now available to either enlarge the grant amount, or increase the number of grants awarded, if the number of applications warranted such a move.

Would an increase to \$300 for each grant sweeten the pot? Might we redouble our efforts to get the word out to fellow educators? When would the new deadline be? What is the will of our chapter?

This grant was designed to help new teachers create a classroom library. Applications are due November 1, 2018 and recipients may receive an award up to \$200. Members were urged to pass this information on to new teachers at your sites or school administrators.

Beta Kappa discussed that they were going to be in charge of all aspects of Bunco. Due to a lot of

questions by both groups, Beta Kappa felt that this would be a better way to proceed and we could discuss next year about having the two chapters sharing the responsibilities.
